#### INTRODUCTION TO DOHA - DOH01

The name Doha may have originated from the Arabic Ad-Dawha, "the big tree", with reference to the big tree that stood on the site where the original fishing village arose. Today, Doha is considered the outstanding "Jewel of Qatar" and we invite you on a half-day excursion to discover this amazing city, combining different architectures and cultures. Enjoy a sightseeing city tour before heading for the atmospheric Souq (Souq Waqif) in "Old Doha", which is one of the most bustling areas of the city. Evolved from a weekend market where the Bedouins traded meat, wool and other products, it is now a maze of narrow alleyways filled with small shops, with goods piled high to the ceilings and spilling out onto the pavement, and with separate sections selling dress, tools, general hardware, spices, incense, Arabic perfumes, sweets and dried fruits. Highlights are the Falcon Souq as well as the Gold & Diamond Souq and the Spice Street & Animal Souq. Next, you will reach the MIA - the Museum of Islamic Art, putting Doha on the world art scene. The Museum of Islamic Art is aiming to hold the largest collection of Islamic art in the world - a bridge from the past to the future of artworks dating from the 7th- to the 19th-century, representing the full scope of Islamic Art. It includes manuscripts, ceramics, metal, glass, ivory, textiles, wood, and precious stones from three continents. After the visit to the museum you will reach the port.

The best Architects from around the globe have competed in creating a "state-of-the-art" horizon. Refreshments and a delicious on-board BBQ will be served, so taste it and simply relax and soak up the sun on board while cruising back to land at a leisurely pace.


## CITY TOUR

**PANORAMIC DOHA - DOH10**

Taking up half a day of your time, this tour promises to deliver the very best of Doha, Qatar's capital and a city that succeeds in blending modern with traditional architecture. Enjoy an amazing coach drive through some of Doha's most prominent and scenic landmarks. The route begins with passing the Museum of Islamic Art, near the city's dhow harbour and continues through the Corniche, West Bay and the Diplomatic area, Katara Cultural Village and The Pearl. A man-made island, The Pearl resembles the shape of an oyster - albeit one measuring an impressive 400 hectares/988 acres and provides more than 32 km/20 miles of new coastline, along which around 19,000 residential units will be built for about 45,000 residents. A stop is scheduled along the itinerary for you to take some photographs for your memory book. Your final port of call will then be the Souq Waqif, a vast inner-city bazaar that dates back to the 19th century but was fully refurbished using only traditional building materials between 2004 and 2006. Brimming with the most diverse goods, from gold and textiles to spices and live animals, the Souq is an experience that will engage all your senses. The outing then wraps up with your return to the ship.

## BEST OF DOHA - DOH29

Created with the aim of introducing you to as much of the Qatari capital as possible, this full-day excursion combines culture, ancient traditions, and the flavours of local cuisine. Leaving the port, the tour begins with a coach drive passing through the Corniche and West Bay to reach Katara village, the ideal destination for all art and architecture lovers and a must for any visit to Doha. Enjoy a guided walk through Katara Cultural Village, a cultural and commercial complex including an amphitheatre, an opera house, a multipurpose cinema, and the magnificent Katara Beach. Your next stop will be at The Pearl, an artificial island shaped like an oyster and an occasion to take photographs for your memory book. Then, an approximately 30-minute coach ride will take you to your next destination, the 3-2-1 Olympic and Sports Museum. Considered as one of the most innovative sports museums, it brims with interactive exhibits, inspiring artefacts, and purpose-built activity areas for diverse audiences. But if you want to capture the true essence of a country, you should definitely discover its typical markets. Your next stop, therefore, will be Souk Waqif in Doha's historic quarter, a lively bazaar that began as a weekend market where Bedouins sold meat, wool, and other products and has now been recently renovated with a myriad of small shops divided into various sections according to the products on offer, ranging from clothing to falcons. Once your batteries recharged with a delicious lunch in a restaurant, continue with a guided visit to National Museum of Qatar, where the rich history of Qatar unfolds across eleven striking galleries, each using engaging and innovative approaches to storytelling. This immersive experience utilizes music, oral histories, film, archival footage, and even evocative aromas to paint a one-of-a-kind portrait of Qatar's past, present and future. This complete experience of Doha ends with the return to the port.

## DOHA BY BIKE - DOHBK1

Experience a few hours of cultural flair in Qatar's fast-growing capital from the unique perspective of a bike. After leaving the port, your route will take you along the Corniche to the colourful sights of Doha's city centre. As well as its breathtaking skyline, Doha's traditions are equally impressive, as you'll discover at the city's Dhow Port. After a quick photo stop, head to the Msheireb Enrichment Centre, where you'll see the city's development up close. Weaving your way through skyscraper canyons, you'll cycle back to the Corniche and on to the highlight of your tour, the Souk Waqif, where you'll find traditional clothing, spices, and handicrafts. Your guide will leave you plenty of time to explore before leading you along the promenade and back to the ship.

Please note: Guests shall cycle for approx. 25 km. Children who are at least 155 cm tall are welcome to take part in this tour with the parent's/guardian's written consent.

## EXPLORING DOHA BY PEDELEC - DOHBK2

Take this fun opportunity to explore Doha, the capital of Qatar, while getting some gentle exercise on an upgrade to the humble bicycle, the electric-assisted pedelec. You'll begin your tour of discovery with a ride along the waterfront Corniche into the city centre and then to the Dhow Port for a photo stop. Then it's off to the Msheireb Enrichment Centre, where an exhibition charts Qatar's fascinating history and development. You'll then cycle through streets lined with soaring buildings to the Katara Cultural Village. Here you'll have time to visit the beach, take a break in one of the nearby restaurants or simply soak up Qatari culture before cycling back to the Corniche. As a final highlight, you'll visit Souq Waqif, a standing market selling clothes, spices, handicrafts, and souvenirs. It is housed in a building of typical Qatari architecture that dates back more than 100 years and has recently been restored. Finally, your guide will escort you back to the ship via the promenade.

Please note: This tour covers a total distance of approximately 40 km. A pedelec can reach a maximum speed of 25km/h with electric assistance. Children who are at least 155 cm tall are welcome to take part in this tour with the parent's/guardian's written consent.

## Bahrain

### CITY TOUR

#### A VISIT TO BAHRAIN - BAH01

Duration  
4 h

This half-day look at some of Bahrain's key attractions begins in Manama, the capital of this island nation, with a visit to the Al-Fateh Grand Mosque, one of the world's largest. Blending a variety of architectural styles typical of the Middle East, the huge, modern edifice boasts the largest fibreglass dome on the planet, can accommodate 7,000 worshippers at one time and houses the National Library of Bahrain. Moving on, you can then relax on a drive through Manama, passing such modern marvels as the Bahrain National Museum, the Bahrain World Trade Centre, the Financial Harbour, and the city's glitzy shopping malls. Your next destination is proof of how Bahrain has always been a centre of traders since ancient times. A step back in time then follows at Bahrain Fort, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Excavations carried out since the 1950s have revealed distinct strata belonging to various eras stretching all the way back to around 2300 B.C. After this visit, you will reach Manama Souq to wander through its maze-like streets, whose plethora of items include clothes, spices, antiques, medicinal concoctions, and a whole lot more. Last up is a photo stop at the amazing Bahrain World Trade Centre on your way back to your ship.

Please note: limited number of guides in languages other than English. Should a tour guide for your language be unavailable, the tour will be in English only. This tour is unsuitable for guests with walking difficulties. Guests visiting the Mosque should wear conservative attire: loose-fitting clothes, long trousers and no transparent garments, shorts, or short skirts, which are considered disrespectful. Ladies should take a headscarf to cover their heads and keep their shoulders covered. On religious celebrations, the Mosque visit will be outside only. Guests should take off their shoes upon entering the Mosque and not touch any architectural features inside. This tour operates with am and pm departures. Depending on the traffic on the day of the excursion, your visit may last between four and five hours.

### CULTURE AND HISTORY

#### BAHRAIN CULTURAL TOUR - BAH03



Designed to shine a light on Bahrain's rich cultural history, this half-day tour begins at the Bahrain National Museum, whose collection includes a relocated burial mound from 2800 B.C., artefacts from the Dilmun era as well as 19th- and 20th-century exhibits related to the pearl trade. Next up is Muharraq city - home to narrow lanes with beautifully restored old houses - to visit the recently renovated Shaikh Ebrahim Bin Mohammed Al Khalifa Center, a cultural landmark featuring the Kurar house dedicated to the time-honoured craft of gold embroidery and the Iqra Children's Library. A chance to rub shoulders with locals then follows at Muharraq Souq, the perfect place to browse among the numerous shops selling traditional perfumes, local sweets, spices, and traditional Arabic medicine before reaching Bahrain Fort, the capital of the Dilmun culture. Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2005, the fortress stands on a small hill artificially created from the debris left by the various settlements that have taken place over the centuries. During the visit, as well as admiring the excavations that are still in progress, you will discover various structures, archways, and remains of buildings up to the fortress proper, Qal'at al-Bahrain, which is located at the highest part of the hill, also known as the Portuguese Fortress. The tour ends with a return to the port.

This tour involves walking on uneven ground. Guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part.





The first stop will be at the world's largest solar park based on the IPP (Independent Power Producer) model, which has a planned production capacity of 5.000 MW by 2030. The park also helped DEWA - the Dubai Electricity and Water Authority - win the best sustainable project of the year in the UAE at the 2014 MEED Quality Awards. This is the first time this award has been given to a renewable energy project in the Middle East and North Africa. The visit to the park includes an introductory video, followed by an educational tour to learn about the history of electricity with hands-on experiments. In the light zone, you will learn about the properties of light with interactive exhibits before concluding in the solar zone where you will see how the sun's energy is harnessed to convert it into electricity using different methods. After visiting the Solar Park, your next stop is the Sheikh Mohamed Cultural Centre where you will be welcomed by the centre's friendly and knowledgeable staff. Enjoy a traditional Emirati lunch before heading to the historic Al Fahidi neighbourhood of Bastakiya, one of the oldest traditional Emirati neighbourhoods in Dubai. A walking along its characteristic narrow alleys (sikkas) allows you to see the beautiful wind towers, an early form of air conditioning. The tour concludes with the return to the port.
